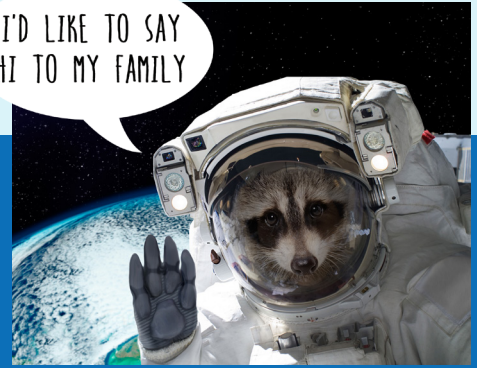

- The anthology will be published on our new Trail Blazer Press and presented after the Teen Writers Workshop on July 26.

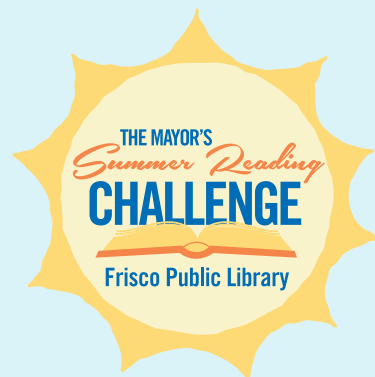
