A limerick is a poem that is funny or nonsensical. Limericks were made famous by Edward Lear, a famous author who wrote the "Book of Nonsense" in the 1800's.

In a limerick, lines 1, 2, and 5 rhyme, and lines 3 and 4 rhyme. This rhyme scheme is **AABBA**.
