Pencil Game: Obstruction

How to Play

- You will need paper, pencil, and an opponent.
- One player is "O"; the other player is "X."
- Create a grid of squares at least 6×6. You can create larger grids for longer more challenging games.
- Each player takes turns writing their mark (X or O) in one of the squares on the grid.
- A player can only mark a square **if** the adjacent squares (including the diagonals) are empty.
- The first player unable to move loses.
