## Pencil Game: Obstruction

## How to Play

- You will need paper, pencil, and an opponent.
- One player is " $O$ "; the other player is " $X$."
- Create a grid of squares at least $6 \times 6$. You can create larger grids for longer more challenging games.
- Each player takes turns writing their mark ( X or O ) in one of the squares on the grid.
- A player can only mark a square if the adjacent squares (including the diagonals) are empty.
- The first player unable to move loses.
