Make a To Do List App Using Javascript

No coding experience required! Get started learning the fundamentals of coding common to all coding languages by creating a simple To Do List app using the free online tool CodeSandbox. This is great as an individual activity or as a family activity you can do with your kids (ages 12 and up).

What you will need:

- Laptop/Desktop (Windows, Mac, Chromebook)
- Internet connection

Getting Set Up:

1. Click **Create Sandbox** on the top right of this [website](#).
2. Click **React by CodeSandbox** under official templates.
3. Copy and paste this into the "App.js" file (This is just some starter code)

import React, { Component } from "react";

class App extends Component {
  render() {
    return (
      <div className="App">

      </div>
    );
  }
}

export default App;
```

To Do List App: In this project you will create an app that allows you to create a list which you can use to keep track of a list of items. You will be using the language ReactJS which allows you to make single-page applications. Everything in this video will be coded in the "App.js" file.
