## Activities at Home

### Number Writing Salt Tray

#### Supplies:

Table salt, sand, or rice  
A tray (at least 1 inch deep)  
Paintbrush  
Blank notecards  
Marker



#### Directions:

Fill the tray with an even layer of salt, sand, or rice.

On each blank notecard use the marker to draw a number on one side and the corresponding number of dots on the other.

Prop the card up in the back of the tray with the dots or the number facing the child.



Encourage your child to copy the number or count the dots and write the correct

number in the tray. If showing dots, flip the card around and see if they wrote the correct number. If not, shake the tray and try again. For older children, have them use the wooden end of the paintbrush to draw in the tray.
