Ramadan Binoculars

These fun binoculars will help you sight the crescent moon during Ramadan. You will need:

- Two cardboard tubes
- Cellophane
- Two rubber bands
- 2 sheets of purple construction paper or felt
- White or yellow paper
- Gold or yellow star stickers
- Yarn
- Tape
- Hot glue gun, plus glue stick
- Pencil
- Scissors



- 1. Draw a small crescent shape on your white or yellow paper and cut it out. The crescent needs to be smaller than the opening of your cardboard tubes.
- 2. Cut two square pieces of cellophane. The squares should measure 4"x4". Glue the crescent to one of the squares.
- 3. Wrap the cellophane squares around the ends of the cardboard tubes (one square per tube). Secure the cellophane in place with rubber bands.
- 4. Trim each sheet of purple construction paper or felt so that they can be wrapped around the cardboard tubes.
- 5. Glue the purple paper or felt to the cardboard tubes using your hot glue gun and glue stick.
- 6. Glue the two purple tubes together to form binoculars.
- 7. Attach a length of yarn to the inside of each cardboard tubes using tape. Make sure the yarn is long enough to be worn around the neck.
- 8. Decorate the binoculars with gold or yellow star stickers.

Now you are ready to spot the crescent moon during Ramadan!
