# Activities at Home

## **Corner Bookmark**


Make a unique bookmark so you never lose your place!

### You will need:


- Paper or cardstock
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Markers, colored pencils, crayons

#### How to make it:


1. On a piece of paper or cardstock, use a ruler to make a 5" by 5" square in one corner.




2. Using your ruler, mark the mid-point of each side of the square, at 2.5".




3. Draw a line to connect the middle points and make four smaller squares.




4. Draw a straight line from corner to corner of the top left and bottom right squares.





5. Cut off the grayed out parts of the shape.




6. Fold each top point down to the opposite corner







7. Glue the top flap onto the bottom flap. Your bookmark should now stay closed like this



8. Now it's time to decorate! Then slide it onto the corner of your page and never lose your place!



Tips:

- If you want to make many bookmarks, save the cut out shape from step 5 to use as a template to trace.
- You can use scrapbook paper instead of plain paper or cardstock to create a colorful bookmark.
