Unique painting techniques!

Did you know you can use everyday materials to make one-of-a-kind paintings? Try using these 3 items on your next painting to create some unique textures.

Plastic wrap: Add a piece of plastic wrap over a layer of acrylic paint or watercolors and move it around the painting. After the paint dries, remove the plastic and you'll be left with amazing web like patterns!

Bubble wrap: Use a brush to apply different colors to a piece of bubble wrap, then stamp the piece on a canvas or piece of paper. Check out the honeycomb-like pattern that the bubble wrap makes!

Sponges: sponges are a fantastic tool for painting. A plain dish sponge can make some amazing textures and can be used to blend colors easily. You can also use scissors to cut the sponge and make your own stamp.
