- Include your responses to the questions below with this application. Please include your first and last name on all additional pages.

2. What is it about Communication Camp that sparked your interest?
3. Tell us about a time that something didn't work out the way you had planned. What did you learn from that experience?
4. Why should you be selected to attend Communication Camp?
