DIY Hummingbird Feeder

Hummingbirds arrive in North Texas early to mid-March and stay until October.

Therefore, there is still time to take on this family project and build your own

hummingbird feeder to hang in the backyard. Here's how:

Supplies:

- Water Bottle (plastic)
- Straws
- Scissors
- o Hot Glue Gun
- o Red & Yellow Foam (for flowers to decorate the feeder)
- Bakers Twine

Instructions:

- 1. Trace and cut flowers out of foam
- 2. Poke holes in the water bottle
- 3. Cut straws and glue (with the hot glue gun) on the holes
- 4. Glue flowers over the straws
- 5. Tie Bakers twine around the bottle

How to Make Hummingbird Food:

- o ½ cup sugar
- o 2 cups water
- 1. Bring to boil and let cool
- 2. Pour into bird feeder then attach feeder to a tree
