







Podcasting (Video & Audio) Getting Started Guide

- 1. Place camera and tripod for capture.** (converting Video and audio into digital signals that allow it to be shared across internet platforms)

<p>a) Connect camera to RodeX on the desk with the mini-HDMI to HDMI cable (the mini-HDMI side will go in right side of camera, the full sized HDMI is plugged into back of RodeX/StreamerX equipment)</p>	
<p>b) Connect the Rode wireless receiver to the camera with to XLR/Aux cable c) Open Edius 9 software</p>	
<p>d) Select “New Project” and pick the preset appropriate to your project</p>	
<p>e) Click “System Settings” in the Settings menu, and make sure the hardware selected is Rode X</p>	

<p>f) Click "Batch Capture" in the Capture menu to select Rode X as input setting</p>	
<p>g) Click "Capture" in the capture menu to start recording</p>	

**** Make sure to remove and take your SD card before leaving the Studio. ****
