



Podcasting Getting Started Guide with Wired Microphones

1. Wired Microphone Setup


<p>a) Plug the XLR cable into the Focusrite Scarlett audio interface. If using multiple microphones, repeat in slot 2.</p>	
<p>b) Press the 48V button to get Phantom Power (this provides power to the mics)</p>	

2. To Record:

<p>c) Open Pro Tools software</p>	
<p>d) Select “new” and check “Create from Template”.</p> <p>e) Select “Focusrite Template”.</p> <p>f) Change the name of the project to your preference.</p> <p>g) Click “create”.</p> <p>You can also record with OBS Studio *Please note that OBS studio is not an editing software. It is primarily used for streaming and video recording.</p>	

Podcasting Getting Started Guide with Wireless Microphones

1. Wireless Microphone Setup

- a) Turn on the Rode wireless receiver by pressing the  button on top.
- b) Turn on wireless microphone 1 and wireless microphone 2 using the same button.



2. To record:

- c) Plug the Rode wireless receiver into the Focusrite Scarlett audio interface with the XLR to Aux cable.

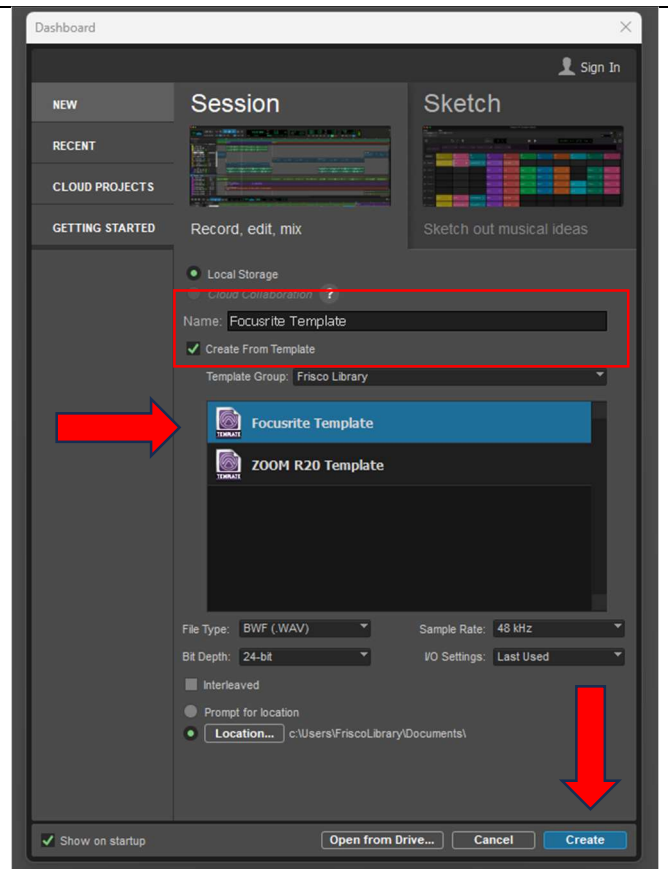


- d) Open Pro Tools software



- e) Select “new” and check “Create from Template”.
- f) Select “Focusrite Template”.
- g) Change the name of the project to your preference.
- h) Click “create”

You can also record with OBS Studio
*** Please note that OBS studio is not an editing software. It is primarily used for streaming and video recording**



**** Make sure to remove and take your SD card before leaving the Studio. ****
